Jesus' name. Amen**

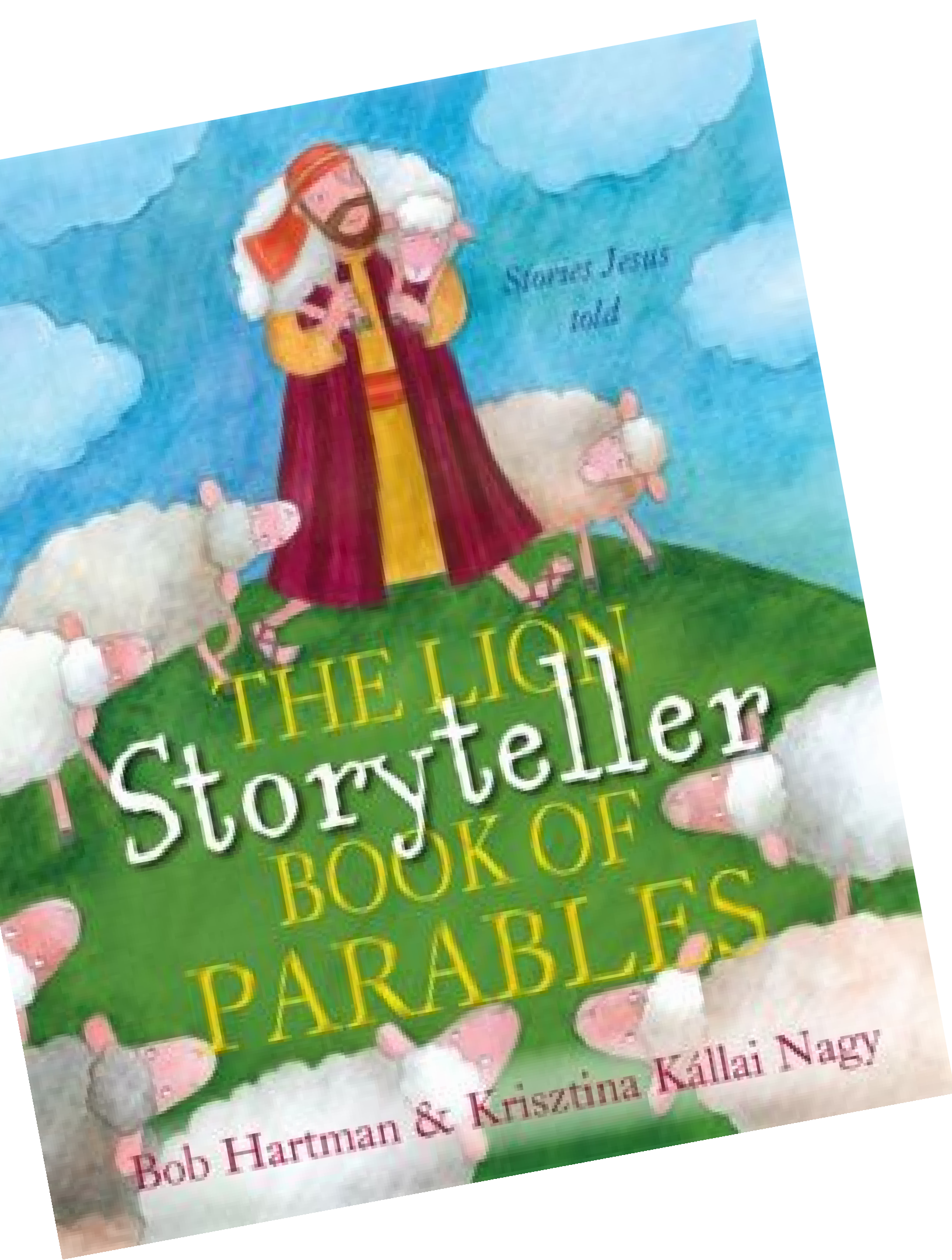
When we **gather**, we bring together and take in.

Harvest time is a season of gathering - bringing together and taking in the crops that have grown.
