Relay and relevel floor slabs to chancel.
- New underfloor heating system designed to fit under new stone flooring to Nave and Chantry Chapel, to be run off existing gas boiler.
- Adjustments to doors to choir vestry and to timber screen to suit new floor level.
- New joinery to include new door to rood screen doorway, alcove door in porch, new notice boards and new enclosure to Ellacombe Chimes apparatus.
- Removal of remaining fixed pews and adjustments to make a selection mobile.
- Removal of plinth and repositioning of font.
- Removal of stone steps and stone base to pulpit at north East corner of nave and fitting new timber base to pulpit.
- Dado panelling to be refurbished and augmented to extend along walls of Nave, and made to conceal perimeter booster heating.
- Repositioning existing servery along south wall of Nave.
- New low energy lighting and new power outlets
